


## **NEW YEAR'S DAY RECEPTION**

# INTERRUPTION OF WATER SERVICE TO ENTIRE PROPERTY

In mid-January 2023, the water service to the entire property will be interrupted periodically while a plumbing contractor conducts the annual testing of our backflow prevention valve. This valve is attached to the main water line from the City and County and is intended to prevent contaminated water from flowing backwards into the City and County water system in the event their pumps fail causing a loss of City pressure. During

the actual test the water should only be off for brief periods at any one time but due to the various phases of the test we cannot pin down the exact times so you will need to plan on not having water pressure for the entire period. **Also, the contractor may** 

have to perform some repairs on the interior mechanisms. If this is necessary the water will be off for up to two full hours while this work is done. Accordingly, if you think you may need water between the above hours you should draw it and set it aside prior



to the above times. Because this affects the entire property you will not be able to utilize any of the common area water supplies either. We do apologize for the inconvenience; however, this work is required by the Board of Water Supply to ensure the safety of their water distribution systems.

## RECYCLING OF CHRISTMAS TREES

As we do each year, we will be recycling Christmas trees again for all of our residents. All trees should be left in the area above and behind the car wash hoses, above the large trash bin that is staged in our Car Wash Area. **PLEASE REMEMBER** that you will need to remove all decorations, flocking, nails, etc., from your tree for it to be accepted by the recycling facility. Please

**<u>DO NOT</u>** place your trees inside the trash bin. We will be staging all of the trees and will bring in a separate trash bin a little later so they can be recycled into mulch. We also ask that you pick up a **FREE PLASTIC <u>BAG</u>** to place your tree inside of before you bring it down in the elevators. This really helps alleviate the additional mess in our



hallways and elevators, which our staff must then clean; and, also prevents fouling of the elevator door tracks which can prevent the elevators from operating properly. You can get one of these bags from Security at the Guardhouse or from the Management Office. Thanks for your help!

### HOUSECLEANING REMINDER

A reminder that the large trash bin in our Car Wash Area will be here through approximately <u>Sunday</u>, <u>January 15<sup>th</sup></u> for your use in disposing of unwanted household items. After that date, nothing except Christmas trees may be placed into the bin. Again, you may dispose of any large items of furniture or rubbish that you may not want to pay hauling charges for. As we mentioned before however, the landfill <u>will not take</u> refrigerators, air conditioners, televisions, computers or monitors, washer/dryers, mattresses or any type of petroleum products (oil or gas). Most other items are okay. Please give us a call if you are not sure about something you would like to place in the bin.

# NEW YEAR'S EVE FIREWORKS

Just a reminder that fireworks are not permitted to be used on Mauna Luan premises. Although we realize that some of our residents would like to "cut loose" for New Year's Eve, the majority of our residents would still like to maintain the noise at a reasonable level, so fireworks and loud parties will need to be taken elsewhere. ### **UPCOMING PROJECTS**

In the coming year we will have a number of fairly large projects occurring around the Mauna Luan. One important one will be the installation of smoke detectors in all apartments at the Mauna Luan as part of our fire safety evaluation that was performed earlier this year. If you already have smoke detectors that are newer and in good operating condition, you can probably keep those as long as they are installed in proper locations. If not, we will have new ones installed for you. We are hoping to be moving forward with the process of obtaining proposals and permits for the renovation of the property entry, including moving the guardhouse. This will exause a lot of disruption with traffic so we will appreciate everyone's help and cooperation to make this work go as smoothly as possible. We are also looking at resurfacing of the top deck of our West parking garage and putting down a waterproof membrane. This will require relocation of all vehicles that park there. We will attempt to arrange alternate parking, however, if we cannot, vehicles will need to be relocated during the work. If time permits, we may also be performing plumbing inspections in all apartments and cleaning of our dryer ducts for both buildings. Again, due to the coordination necessary, we may not get to all of these, but have them in our schedule. If anyone has any questions, please contact the Management Office.
