### USE OF DRAINS

We wanted to pass on some information related to the use of your drains to help prevent clogs and backups that tend to ruin everyone’s day. You should never treat your garbage disposal as a trash can. You need to be very careful of what you put down your drains. As an example, **NEVER** pour cooking oil or grease down the drain. When hot it may seem fine as it is still in a liquid state. However, once the oil/grease begins to cool it will not continue running down the drain but will harden and begin to build up in the line eventually causing a blockage. Although your garbage disposal can chop up many items, there are a lot that still should not go down the drains. Any type of vegetable peels when wet will become a heavy mass and when it lands at the bottom of the drain stack will stay there collecting additional items until the line is blocked. Other items that should not be placed in the drains would be egg shells, pasta, rice, bread, fibrous meat, etc. All of the above items should be disposed of in your kitchen trash. Please help us to prevent drain backups that tend to cause a lot of water damage in the units where they occur. Mahalo!

## CHRISTMAS TREES IN CONDOS

Because most trees are already 45 to 90 days old when they arrive on the island and there is really no way to keep them fresh through the holidays, we usually recommend the use of artificial trees for the holidays. With an artificial tree you can forego the mess plus you do not have to worry about the fire hazard that a dry tree can present. However, if you do use a real tree, please think safety with the use of tree lights and the placement of the tree. We want to be sure that you and your family have an enjoyable and safe holiday season! Also, when you decide to put your tree up or take it down we will again be providing large plastic bags to place your tree inside of to bring it in or out of the buildings. This helps to contain the pine needles that cause such a mess in the common areas. The bags are **FREE OF CHARGE** so please stop by the office or security guardhouse and get one when you need it.
