

DISPOSAL OF TRASH AND RECYCLING **MATERIALS**

Just a reminder that the hours of use for our trash chutes are from 7:00 a.m. through 10:00 p.m., daily. After that the noise generated by trash coming down the chute is very disturbing to many residents whose apartments are near the trash room. Please be considerate of your neighbors and not use the trash chutes outside of these hours. We also wanted to remind everyone that boxes should not be put into the trash chutes as they normally will lodge somewhere below and block the chute. Although small boxes may go down okay, just to be sure we would like to ask that no boxes be placed into the chutes. You may dispose of them at the ground level trash building inside of the double doors. One other item related to trash and noise is the disposal of recycling materials. The same hours apply to our recycling area so if planning on getting rid of your aluminum cans, please do so at a reasonable hour as the crashing sounds from that area is heard most of the way up the buildings. We would appreciate everyone's consideration in this matter.

POOL PARTY REMINDERS

Due to recurring issues, we wanted to pass on a few reminders regarding the use of our recreational facilities:

- 1. There is a maximum number of guests/people who can be in attendance at pool/barbecue parties. Please remember that the maximum number of non-resident guests permitted per apartment is 10. If you combine two apartments together the maximum number of people is 20. These rules are monitored closely and you will be required to reduce the number of guests/total number of people if you exceed the limit.
- 2. All guests must be accompanied by a host resident when using any of our recreational facilities.

- 3. No food or beverages are permitted within 6 feet of the pools or jacuzzies. No glass items are permitted outside of the Recreation Building or barbecue areas.
- 4. There is no ball playing permitted in any of the recreation areas, including the pools and jacuzzies.
- 5. Marco Polo is not permitted in the pool areas due to the noise that this game generates.
- 6. Water guns and pump up canons are not permitted in the pool areas.

Your help and cooperation will be appreciated to allow everyone to enjoy our pool areas. Mahalo.

APARTMENT RENOVATION WORK

As most residents are aware, we seem to have apartment renovations in progress around the Mauna Luan pretty much all the time. Any apartment renovation or upgrade does also require a request form to be completed and




turned in to the office prior to starting any work. You may obtain a copy of this request form from the office. Because these renovations generate a lot of noise at certain times, we do require that all owners notify the Management Office whenever they have work scheduled that will generate noise.

This is so we can provide notice to surrounding apartments



making neighbors aware that they might want to plan on being out at those times. Most of the noisiest projects tend to include removal/installation of flooring; demolition of old cabinets and installing of new ones; remodeling of bathrooms; etc. So, if you are

HOLD MAIL REMINDER



Just a reminder to our residents who put in "hold mail" requests when being away from their apartments for any length of time. Our mail carrier has asked that you not list your day of return as the day that you would like

your mail brought to the Mauna Luan. This is because most residents do not arrive at the Mauna Luan early enough to be here when the mail carriers are delivering their mail. Since held mail is brought when the mail carrier is performing the regular daily delivery, this is the only time you can have your held mail delivered to you. Because of this, unless you wish to go to the post office and pick up all of your mail you need to be home at the time of the mail delivery if you would like the mail carrier to bring your held mail to you. The mail carriers will greatly appreciate everyone's help with this. Mahalo!
