



On **Monday, May 2, 2022**, Appearance Inc. will be here for the quarterly cleaning of the exterior apartment windows here at the Mauna Luan. We will post notices on the 1st, 3rd and 5th elevator landings in each building the week prior to this cleaning as a reminder to everyone. As before, on the day of your cleaning all plants will need to be removed from exterior planter boxes, and if you have screens blocking access to any of your windows, they will need to be removed also. Here is the tentative window washing schedule:

- Mon, 5/2/22 - West A,B,C apts
- Tue, 5/3/22 - West D,E,F,G,H apts
- Wed, 5/4/22 - West J,K,L apts
- Thu, 5/5/22 - East A,B,C apts
- Fri, 5/6/22 - East D,E,F,G,H apts
- Sat, 5/7/22 - East J,K,L apts
- Mon, 5/9/22 - Overflow Day

If the weather does not cooperate, this schedule is subject to change. We will keep you updated with daily notices on the elevator landings. If you have any questions please contact the Management Office at 395-7544.

WATER SHUTDOWN FOR ENTIRE PROPERTY

On **Tuesday, May 3, 2022 between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and approximately 3:00 p.m.**, the water service to the entire property will be off while a plumbing contractor replaces our backflow prevention valve that provides water service to the entire property. This valve is attached to the main water line from the City



and County and is intended to prevent contaminated water from flowing backwards into the City and County water system in the event their pumps fail causing a loss of City pressure. Accordingly, if you think you may need water between the above hours you should draw it and set it aside prior to the above times. Because this affects the entire property you will not be able to utilize any of the common area water supplies either. **PLEASE NOTE: To help prevent air from being trapped in the water lines when we bring the water back on, it is requested that you NOT RUN any water out of the pipes during the shutdown period. Also, since there will be at least some air trapped in the water lines when you return home that evening, we need to ask everyone to turn on the water faucets everywhere in your unit (including tubs and showers) for a few minutes to help bleed out any trapped air from the system. You will not need to run the water for very long; just long enough to see if any air is trapped. BY ALL MEANS, be sure to shut off any fixture if you turn it on by mistake during the shutdown. This will help prevent flooding from overflowing sinks, etc. We do apologize for the inconvenience; however, this work needs to be done to ensure the safety of our water distribution systems.**

SUMMER TIME AND USE OF RECREATIONAL FACILITIES

A reminder that as we head into our summer months the use of our recreational facilities normally increases a great deal with out-of-state visitors or more frequent family get-togethers. Usually, when there is a larger number of people using the facilities our pool noise tends to increase also to where the levels may go beyond reasonable and disturb other residents. The Mauna Luan has the distinction of being designed like a vacation resort although we are in fact a residential





community. All residents need to understand that with facilities such as ours it is inevitable that there will be noise from the pool areas whenever there are groups of people using them. Those of us using the facilities also need to be especially aware of this problem and try to prevent loud, boisterous

activity and horseplay while using the pool areas. Included in horseplay is tossing children into the air, playing loud games such as Marco Polo, and other loud activities. Here are some reminders regarding safety issues as well. The water slide is only to be used one at a time and you must be in a sitting position, facing the pool. Our rocks are there for aesthetic purposes and are not to be used as diving boards for the pools. Our pools are very shallow which is why there are 'no diving' signs all around the pool. This is for your own safety no matter how experienced you may think you are. Also please remember that all persons under the age of 12 must have a responsible adult supervising them otherwise they cannot be in the pool areas, including the hot tubs, alone. Your help with the above will be appreciated to help make everyone's summer an enjoyable one. Mahalo!

No other personal items or property may be left in or around the parking garage. That would mean that you cannot unload your trunk and leave a lot of items in the stall or have a bicycle stored there, etc. Also, we many times find old batteries or other car parts behind parking stalls.
