PARKING STALL USE

We wanted to pass on a reminder regarding the use of parking stalls in the garage. The house rules permit the use of the parking stalls for motor vehicles and boats (jet skis) on trailers that fit within the space of the parking stalls. No other items may be stored or left in or around the parking stalls. That means that you cannot leave your vehicle washing materials; bicycles; beach items such as chairs, umbrellas, etc.; baby strollers, surfboards or any other personal items, in or next to, the parking stalls. Your help and cooperation to ease the clutter this causes will be appreciated.

SWIMMING POOL USE

Over the past few months we have been receiving reports of parents taking small babies into our swimming pools without the required swimming diapers. In some cases the mother was actually seen removing regular diapers and putting on swimming trunks to take her baby into the pool. Due to sanitary issues if the baby was to have a bowel movement with only trunks on, we need to insist that anyone not toilet-trained wear swimmer diapers, designed specifically for that purpose. It is very inconvenient to others if someone has a bowel movement in a pool since it will need to be closed while the water is filtered completely. Everyone's cooperation in this matter will be appreciated.
