


CANDIDATES FOR MAUNA LUAN BOARD OF DIRECTORS

HECO POWER OUTAGE

Hawaiian Electric Company (HECO) has just notified us of their scheduled date for the final transformer replacement for the Mauna Luan. This final change-out will only affect the West Building units. The East Building and all common areas will not be affected this time as those transformers were replaced during their first two power outages. This power outage is scheduled for Wednesday, August 17, 2022 between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. Accordingly, all West Building residents should make a note of this and plan your day accordingly. You will have water to your apartment in the event you wish to remain at home but you will not have electricity inside your unit. If you have any special needs that may be affected by not having electricity for the above period, you will need to make arrangements to take care of that. CLOSING OF ONE LANE ON GARAGE RAMP FOR CONCRETE REPAIR

Beginning on <u>Tuesday, July 5, 2022 and continuing for the</u> <u>next week or so,</u> a contractor will be performing concrete repair to multiple sections of the ceiling on the bottom section of the garage ramp; this is the last section that comes down to the light/stop sign just before you leave the garage. During this work it will be necessary to close the down ramp during the day for the safety of the workers as they will be working in the driving lane. Because of this we will need to hold up vehicles either coming in or going out so that everyone can use the up lane to enter and exit. This will cause some delays so we urge everyone to plan accordingly so you have sufficient time to get to where you may be going. We will appreciate everyone's patience and cooperation during this work. Mahalo!

TIME FOR SUMMER HOUSE **CLEANING!**

Beginning on Friday, July 15, 2022, we are scheduled to have a large trash bin located in our Car Wash Area for everyone's use to help rid



ourselves of any accumulated junk and unwanted items that you have collected throughout the year. This is your chance to clear out any old furniture, boxes, or do something as crazy as cleaning out your storage lockers. Imagine all of that extra space you'll have! There are a few restrictions on what can be disposed of in this bin due to environmental regulations. We are not permitted to put refrigerators, televisions, computer monitors or other electric appliances, air conditioners, petroleum products (gas or oil), paints, tires, or anything that has any type of motor oil in it that could leak into the ground. All types of furniture, wood, or other similar items are okay. This trash bin will be staged in the Car Wash Area for about two weeks so please take advantage of this opportunity. NO-SMOKING RULES

AUTHORIZED ITEMS IN HALLWAYS

Please remember that the only items that may be set out in front of the apartments are an authorized number of plants and a doormat. Residents must also be aware of the size of the plants

so they do not obstruct normal passage in the hallways and all plants must be properly contained so they do not leak water onto the hallway floor and cause staining. Ceramic objects, coconuts, pieces of coral, brass ornamental pieces, etc., may not be placed in the hallways. Also, shoes/slippers must be kept inside the apartment door of the apartment and not left in front of the door in the hallway. Thank you for your help!



Just a quick reminder that fireworks are not permitted to be used on Mauna Luan premises. Although some of our residents may really like to "cut loose," the majority of our residents would still like to maintain the noise at a reasonable level, so we need to ask that all fireworks and loud parties be taken elsewhere. Your cooperation will be greatly appreciated by everyone!

PLEASE REMEMBER TO USE HEADLIGHTS AND OBSERVE SPEED LIMITS & ALL STOP SIGNS AT ALL TIMES WHILE IN THE PARKING STRUCTURE AND OTHER AREAS OF THE PREMISES! THIS IS ESPECIALLY IMPORTANT AT THE BOTTOM OF THE GARAGE RAMP! MAHALO.

DISPOSAL OF LARGE ITEMS/BOXES

Just a reminder that all large items or boxes need to be brought to the ground floor trash bins for disposal and not forced into the trash chutes or left sitting inside the trash room on each floor. Also, when you do bring your boxes down please do not just put them in the open trash bin assembled. These take up a lot of room and prevent other residents from disposing of items that they bring down. All boxes should be broken down flat and then placed in the bins that way. This will allow much more trash to be placed in this bin. Your help is appreciated.
