

WINDOW WASHING

On Monday, September 14, 2020, American Window Cleaning (Appearance Inc.) will be here for the quarterly cleaning of the exterior apartment windows here at the Mauna Luan. We will



post notices on the 1st, 3rd and 5th elevator landings in each building the week prior to this cleaning as a reminder to everyone. As before, on the day of your cleaning all plants will need to be removed from exterior planter boxes, and

if you have screens blocking access to any of your windows, they will need to be removed also. Here is the tentative window washing schedule:

Fri, 9/18/20	-	Overflow day


If the weather does not cooperate, this schedule is subject to change. We will keep you updated with daily notices on the elevator landings. If you have any questions please contact the

Kilauea Pest Control will be here on Tuesday, September 29, 2020 for their quarterly pest control treatment in the units that have contracts with them. The cost for this service is \$180.00 per year/per unit or \$45.00 per treatment if you have it done on the regularly scheduled days. It will cost \$75.00 per treatment on any other day. If you are on this service please be sure that we have an Authorized Entry form signed and in our possession if you will not be home when the technician arrives. If you are not on this service but would like to be, we do have contract forms available in the Management Office or on our website (maunaluan.com). PLEASE NOTE: all requests for service must be made with Kilauea not later than Friday, September 25, 2020, otherwise they may be unable to accommodate you. NO-SMOKING RULES



We continue to receive reports from residents who smell cigarette smoke blowing into their apartments. A reminder that smoking or vaping anywhere on Mauna Luan property, including inside of the apartments, is prohibited. Although most of our residents have been abiding by these new rules; we are still receiving reports and finding places where someone has still been smoking. If this is you, we need to ask that you please stop using the stairwells and/or other places on the property to smoke. Signs have been posted around the property and we have asked that all smokers please help with this adjustment. CARDBOARD BOXES IN TRASH CHUTES



Even after multiple notices we continue to have problems with some residents throwing cardboard boxes down the trash chutes which invariably causes a blockage in the chute. This presents a danger to our staff members who

must then reach inside of the chute to try and pull these boxes out, all while other residents above are dropping other items down the chute. <u>We need to ask again that you take all</u> <u>cardboard boxes to the ground level trash bins, break them</u> down flat and put them in the open bin. Otherwise, these

boxes will wedge themselves inside the chute requiring someone else to try and pull them out. We would really appreciate everyone's help with this issue to prevent injury to our staff and inconvenience to other residents. Mahalo!



INFANT USE OF POOLS

To all of our new parents here at the Mauna Luan we need everyone to please adhere to our rules regarding infants using the swimming pools. To help prevent our having to close the pools due to a bowel accident in the pools, the house rules require that anyone who is not toilet-trained wear an appropriate swimming diaper which is a tight fitting nylon or latex alternative for a typical diaper and help prevent leaks into the pools. Typical disposable or cloth diapers are not permitted in the swimming pools or whirlpools. If anyone has questions on what might be permitted, please contact the Management Office for clarification.

CORONAVIRUS REMINDERS

As everyone should be aware, we are still operating under City & County and State mandates as far as how we live during the COVID pandemic. The most recent order from the Mayor has implemented another stay-at-home/work-



from-home mandate which is effective through at least September 9, 2020. This Order still includes the prohibition on any type of gatherings. Under that Order, indoor and outdoor gatherings of any type and any number of people are prohibited. That includes having friends over to your home. The only exceptions for people coming to the Mauna Luan are for individuals who are here to provide a service or aid/assistance to another resident. Essential workers such as plumbers, electricians and construction people are also permitted. We need to again remind all residents and their guests that you must wear face masks at all times when outside of your apartments and anywhere in the common areas, especially when using the elevators. As noted above, any gatherings in the pool areas or other common areas of two or more people MUST be from the same apartment. We would appreciate everyone's help and cooperation during this time with the mask mandates, social distancing and restriction on gathering. Also, please continue to sanitize and wash your hands whenever you return home to help prevent your getting sick. Mahalo.

POSTAL DELIVERY REMINDERS

Parcel Lockers. Please remember that there are only 8-12 parcel lockers for every 108 or so apartments depending on the location. With everyone ordering online now we get a huge amount of boxes daily and have limited space. All parcels need to be removed from a locker within 2 days. After that all parcels will need to be picked up at the Hawaii Kai Post Office. Please help by checking your box daily for a parcel locker key. Mahalo!
