

# WINDOW WASHING

On <u>Monday, September 18, 2023</u>, American Window Cleaning (Appearance Inc.) will be here for the quarterly cleaning of the exterior apartment windows at the Mauna Luan. We will post notices on the 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> elevator landings in each building the week prior to this cleaning as a reminder to everyone. As before, on the day of your cleaning all plants will need to be removed from exterior planter boxes, and if you have screens blocking access to any of your windows, they will need to be removed also. Here is the tentative window washing schedule:


Mon, 9/18/23	-	West A,B,C,D,E apts

Kilauea Pest Control will be here on <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>September 26</u>, <u>2023</u> for their quarterly pest control treatment in the units that have contracts with them. The cost for this service is now 200.00 per year/per unit or 50.00 per treatment if you have it done on the regularly scheduled days. It will cost 80.00 per treatment on any other day. If you are on this service please be sure that we have an Authorized Entry form signed and in our possession if you will not be home when the technician arrives. If you are not on this service but would like to be, we do have contract forms available in the Management Office or on our website (maunaluan.com). <u>PLEASE NOTE</u>: all requests for service <u>must</u> be made with Kilauea not later than Friday, September 22, 2023, otherwise they may be unable to accommodate you. #### NOISE FROM RENOVATION OF APARTMENTS

As you are probably aware, the Mauna luan always seems to have some type of activity related to renovating in apartments. With so much work being done regularly, we try to keep everyone apprised of when this work will be done so everyone can make plans to avoid the worst of the noise. To that end, we do require residents who are going to be doing renovation work to contact the Management Office in advance to let us know the dates that noise will be generated. That way we can post notices for residents in the area so they know when this noise will be. Also, please remember that any work that will generate noise must be done Monday thru Friday between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. No work is permitted on Saturdays or Sundays. If anyone has questions on this policy please let us know. Mahalo!

### USE OF POOLS AND PROHIBITED ITEMS

We have been experiencing a much greater problem this year with noise coming from our pool areas. A portion of this can be attributed to larger numbers of people using the facilities. However, much of the noise is due to unusually loud screaming and yelling, especially in the evening hours. Please remember that you, as a resident host, are responsible for the conduct of your family and guests. If someone is getting a little louder than normal you should step in and ask them to try to hold the noise down. As reminders, the game of "Marco Polo" is not permitted due to the noise it generates; water guns/cannons may not be used in or around the pools; and, any child who is not toilettrained MUST wear swimming diapers while in any body of water. We understand that with water amenities such as ours the tendency to get loud is an easy one. However, everyone must also remember that you are not at a public pool where noise is not an issue. Our pools front the living units for 434 homes and most of what you do in the pools will be heard in these units. Daytime noise is usually expected and unless too loud, is not as much as a problem as the after dark noise. At that time most other residents are home trying to enjoy dinner and relax. Please think of this when using the pools. Mahalo.

#### Moving of Furniture and Use of Elevators

A reminder that <u>no items of furniture</u> are permitted to be moved in any <u>unpadded</u> elevator. Big or small, anyone moving any item of furniture in an unpadded elevator is subject to a fine under our house rules. This prohibition also applies to **uncovered surfboards**. Surfboards need to be covered to help protect the elevator interiors from sharp edges. If you are not sure what you are moving is permitted, <u>please ask first</u> to ensure that you are not in violation of the house rules. Mahalo!

**Picking Up After Your Dog.** We have been receiving more complaints from residents of finding dog feces around their vehicles and other areas of the property. Just a reminder to our dog owners that in accordance with City & County Ordinances, you MUST pick up after your dog anywhere on the property or outside along the street. Your help in this matter is appreciated.
