RECYCLING OF CHRISTMAS TREES

As we do each year, we will be recycling Christmas trees again for all of our residents. All trees should be left in the grass area above the large trash bin that is staged in our Car Wash Area.

PLEASE REMEMBER that you will need to remove all decorations, flocking, nails, etc., from your tree for them to be accepted by the recycling facility. Please **DO NOT** place your trees inside the trash bin. Our staff will be staging all of the trees and we will bring in a separate trash bin a little later so they can be recycled into mulch. We also ask that you pick up a **FREE PLASTIC BAG** to place your tree inside of before you bring it down in the elevators. This really



helps alleviate the additional mess in our hallways and elevators, which our staff must then clean, and also prevents fouling of the elevator door tracks which can prevent the elevators from operating properly. You can get one of these bags from Security at the Guardhouse or from the Management Office. Thanks for your help!

RE-CODING OF SECURITY KEYS

We will be performing our annual re-coding of all security keys during the month of February 2011. These security keys are the flat metal disks that allow entrance to the main buildings and Recreation Building. They are re-coded each year as part of our security program to weed out lost or stolen keys from the inventory. This process does require a trip to the Management Office by you with **EACH** key. It only takes a minute or so to have your key re-coded and you don't even have to remove it from your key ring. Below is the current schedule for the re-coding:



East Building Residents.....Feb 7 - 12
 West Building Residents.....Feb 14 - 19
 All Others.....Feb 22 - 26

On **Monday, February 28, 2011** we will change all door locks to accept only the new code and no longer accept the old code. If your keys have not been re-coded by that time they will no longer work in the doors. During the time between getting your keys re-coded and the time we change the locks, you do not have to worry about your keys working as they will carry both the new code and the old code. If anyone has any questions regarding this process please contact the Management Office.
