

TESTING OF FIRE ALARM SYSTEMS

On **Wednesday, July 6, 2011 beginning at approximately 9:00 <u>a.m.</u>, Oahu Fire Protection Services will be here to conduct the annual testing of the fire alarms and sprinkler systems here at the**



Mauna Luan. Throughout most of the morning and possibly into the afternoon, you will be hearing the fire alarm sirens sound every time one of the pull stations is tested. They will normally only sound for a few seconds at a time when pulled but since there are three

stations per floor in each building, plus the ones in the parking structure, it is a time consuming and noisy process. We apologize

for any inconvenience this testing may cause but it is a very important part of our overall safety program here at the Mauna Luan and is also required by law. If this will cause undue disruption to you we ask that you please make alternate plans during the testing. Mahalo.

TIME FOR SUMMER HOUSE CLEANING!

Beginning on <u>Monday, July 11, 2011</u>, we are scheduled to have a large trash bin located in our Car Wash Area for everyone's use to help rid ourselves of any accumulated junk that we have collected throughout the year, and also to

dispose of other unwanted items. This is your chance to clear out any old furniture, boxes, or do something as crazy as cleaning out your storage lockers. Imagine all of that extra



space you'll have! There are a few restrictions however, on what can be disposed of in this bin due to environmental regulations. We are not permitted to put refrigerators, televisions, computer monitors or other electric appliances, air conditioners, petroleum products (gas or oil), paints, tires, or anything that has some type of motor oil in it that could leak into the ground. All types of furniture, wood, old renovation materials, or other similar items are okay. This trash bin will be staged in the Car Wash Area for about two weeks so please take advantage of this opportunity. DRIVING REMINDERS



REMINDER REGARDING NOISE FROM POOL AREAS & USE OF FACILITIES

Each year we like to pass on reminders regarding some noise

issues that typically occur during our summer months around the recreation areas. Because of the inconvenience excess noise can cause, many of our residents, especially those living on the lower floors close to the pools, really appreciate consideration being given by



pool users to hold down the noise as much as possible. Again, we need our adult residents to take the responsibility for ensuring that your guests and family members know and adhere to all of our rules for use of the recreation areas. This primarily goes to horseplay; excessively loud talking or screaming; etc. Also, please remember that there is **no diving** permitted in any of our pools due to the shallow water. It does not matter if you were an Olympic swimmer, you still cannot dive into our pools. **The**

water slide may only be used in a sitting position, facing the pool. No spinning, head first, group use, feet first on belly, etc. Due to past problems, security has been instructed to remove individuals from the pools if they have already been previously warned about specific rules or policies and continue to violate them. Please remember that our recreation facilities are private property and for the use and enjoyment of all our residents, not just a few. We are not a water amusement park where out of control noise and activity may be permitted. To avoid not being able to enjoy our facilities, we ask that all responsible adults review the house rules and speak with guests and other family members regarding abiding by them. Everyone will appreciate your consideration.

HOME ENTERTAINMENT SYSTEMS

Just a reminder on the volume levels, to include the bass settings, whenever our residents use their home entertainment systems. Because our buildings are made of concrete, noise is transmitted very easily to surrounding



apartments. This problem is made much worse in the late evening or early morning hours when there is very little noise outside to help mask the sounds. Because of this we would like to ask that everyone be especially cognizant of the noise issues when using these types of systems. Bass settings should always be kept at a low range and if using an entertainment system late at night or early in the morning, please remember that their use is restricted between 10:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m., unless headsets are used.
