On <u>Thursday, July 12, 2012 beginning at approximately 9:00</u> <u>a.m.</u>, Oahu Fire Protection Services will be here to conduct the annual testing of the fire alarms and sprinkler systems here at the



Mauna Luan. Throughout most of the morning and possibly into the afternoon, you will be hearing the fire alarm sirens sound every time one of the pull stations is tested. They will normally only sound for a few seconds at a time when pulled but since there are three

stations per floor in each building, as well as the ones in the parking structure, it is a time consuming and noisy process. We

apologize for any inconvenience this testing may cause but it is a very important part of our overall safety program here at the Mauna Luan and is also required by law. If this will cause undue disruption to you we ask that you please make alternate plans during the testing. Mahalo.

CHANGES TO BASIC CABLE TELEVISION SERVICES

Recently, a notification letter from Oceanic Time Warner Cable was delivered to all Mauna Luan apartments. In this letter Oceanic explained additional services that would be available to Mauna Luan residents effective July 1, 2012 due to a new 5-year agreement being entered into. This new agreement reduces the cost to our owners for the basic service contained in our maintenance fees and also provides FREE services to all residents as well as other services at a reduced cost. The new agreement will provide Standard Cable, Digital Variety Pak (DVP), the primary Digital Cable box, one (1) Digital Video Recorder (DVR), and Showtime Multi-Plex which includes eight Showtime channels plus Showtime On-Demand and Showtime HD, all at no cost to our residents! If any additional boxes or services are desired, Oceanic will bill you separately for those. All residents who already have any of the above services, which you are currently paying for, will see your monthly billings reduced as Oceanic will remove any of these items from your billing effective July 1st. Also as part of this agreement, Oceanic

is offering a reduced rate for both Road Runner and Nationwide Home Phone service. This will only affect those residents who are currently paying the existing rate of \$44.95 for Road Runner or \$39.95 for Nationwide Home Phone. If you are paying these rates, your billing will also reflect a \$10.00 reduction per month for each of these services. To make arrangements for obtaining a Digital Cable Box and/or DVR, you will need to contact Oceanic's Customer Service at 643-2100, on or after July 1st. Also, be sure to ask for the Showtime package. One other additional service being provided with this agreement will be free WiFi in both of our lobby areas. This service will not be available immediately as Oceanic needs to determine how they will get the cable service to each of these areas and then we will need to install the service. We will notify you of when this WiFi service is available and what you need to do to connect to the service. There is also some additional information contained in the letter from Oceanic about this agreement so if you did not receive the first one; discarded it by mistake; or, just need another one, please contact the Management Office and we will provide another copy to you. We urge all residents to take advantage of these free services if you are not already subscribed. If there are any questions, please let us know.
