On <u>Tuesday, July 1, 2014 beginning at approximately 8:30</u> <u>a.m.</u>, Oahu Fire Protection Services will be here to conduct the annual testing of the fire alarms and sprinkler systems here at the



Mauna Luan. Throughout most of the morning and possibly into the afternoon, you will be hearing the fire alarm sirens sound every time one of the pull stations is tested. They will normally only sound for a few seconds at a time when pulled but since there are three

stations per floor in each building, as well as the ones in the parking structure, it is a time consuming and noisy process. We

apologize for any inconvenience this testing may cause but it is a very important part of our overall safety program here at the Mauna Luan and is also required by law. If this will cause undue disruption to you we ask that you please make alternate plans during the testing. Mahalo.

INSTALLATION OF PHOTOVOLTAIC SYSTEM

Most of you are probably wondering why nothing has been done yet on the photovoltaic system that is to be installed on the top, uncovered deck of our parking garage. As we have mentioned in

recent newsletter, we are still in the process of having what is termed an interconnectivity study performed through Hawaiian Electric Company (HECO) for them to determine whether there are any adverse effects to their electric grid having our system tied into it. Based on the estimated time that HECO told us this would take, we are hoping to hear back within the next two months as to their findings. If everything comes out okay we may be able to begin work sometime in the near future.
